Newby Hall near Ripon also plays host to dramatic performance this month with Shakespeare's 'As You Like It' performed in the outdoor theatre by the Lord Chamberlain's Men. A pyrotechnical extravaganza wraps up summer in style at the end of the month with the return of the Firework Championships. Teams compete to create stunning firework displays choreographed to music, with the winner decided by audience votes on the night.
